Quality education. St. John's has a proven record of academic excellence. We emphasize creativity, higher-level thinking, and problemsolving skills. Our students become successful learners.

Making Christ-Centered Education

Affordable



We believe that Christ-centered education is a joint commitment between parents and the church. When we share our resources, we can build a strong faith foundation for more kids. That's why we make intentional choices and investments in affordable, high-quality, Christ-centered education.

Tuition subsidy. St. John's tuition is substantially less than other faith-based options because this school is a mission of St. John's Lutheran Church. The church members contribute 50% of the operating budget needed to run the school. Tuition covers the remaining 50%.

- Bundled pricing. We partner with families who choose St. John's for more than one child in the family. Our per-student tuition fee decreases with each additional student, and is capped for families with four or more children.
- Financial assistance. We hope that money never stands between a child and Christcentered education. We do offer tuition assistance opportunities based on need and circumstances.
